




- You are unable to see apartment
- Does not show exact unit you will be renting
- You have difficulty reaching the Property Manager or Owner
- You're rushed during showing appointment
- Property Manager won't take time to answer questions.
- The Building does not look well kept inside and outside
- If the price or amenities offered seem to good to be true it usually is
- Avoid overly eager or aggressive Property Manager or Owners
- Don't be rushed to sign a lease

- South Side





### Looking for off-campus housing as an international students

- Identification requirement by landlords- i20 and passport (be careful with whom you are sharing this information).
- Beware of Scams- Find rental properties through verifiable sources like Zillow, rather than using social media to look for properties.
- Security Deposit- The security deposit is typically one month's rent, though it can sometimes be up to 1.5 times the rent.
- Touring: It is important to have the chance to see the actual apartment you will be renting before you sign a lease (ask a contact to tour the apartment or ask the landlord to provide you a video tour of the place)
- Connect with international student communities- connect for advice and support to live in the US.
- Check reviews of landlords and management companies.
- Contact us- For support regarding lease requirements, safety concerns, security deposit etc.
