School Ombudspersons

Roles of the Ombudsperson:

- Listen to graduate student/postdoc concerns.
- Explain university and school policies.
- Explain the grade appeal process.
- Act as a neutral resource
- Facilitate communication
- Refer individuals to others as appropriate.
- Keep information confidential except as required by law or university policy

The Ombudsperson does not:

- Change grades.
- Change policies.
- Take sides; goal is mutual understanding between differing points of view.
- Identify individuals without permission, except as required by law or university policy, which includes Title IX issues.
- Take part in formal grievance processes.
